Travel Plan Activities (Itinerary)

Day 1: Arrival – Dar Es Salaam.

Travelling Time: 17 min

Distance: 10.8 km

Arrival at **Julius Nyerere International Airport (DAR)**, where I will personally greet you at the airport together with my team staff. You will then drive to Dar Es Salaam city and check-in at your hotel. Later you will spend your dinner and overnight at **Tiffany Diamond Hotel** https://www.tiffanydiamondhotels.com/

Day 2: Nyerere National Park. - Rufiji River Boat Safari

Travelling Time: 3 hr 44 min

Distance: 213.7 km

After early breakfast you will start your journey to **Nyerere National Park.** Later afternoon you will have a **boat safari** along the mighty Rufiji River. You will discover the Rufiji River by boat, encounter hippos and crocodiles in good numbers. Some 350 bird species have been recorded in the Nyerere National Park. These are typical of miombo woodlands, and the bird life supported by Rufiji swamplands is of particular interest.

The Nyerere National Park is one of the largest faunal reserves in the world located in the south of Tanzania. It was named after Englishman Sir Frederick Selous, a famous big game hunter and early conservationist who died at Beho Beho in this territory in 1917 while

fighting against the Germans during World War I. Later the name changed to **Nyerere National Park.**

Scottish explorer and cartographer, Keith Johnston, also died in Beho Beho in 1879 while leading an RSGS expedition to the Great Lakes of Africa with Joseph Thomson. The Selous was designated as UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1982 due to the diversity of its wildlife and undisturbed nature. Day 3: Nyerere National Park – Full Wildlife Game Drive

After early breakfast **7:00 AM** you will start a **full day game viewing drive** in Nyerere National Park. **The park has the finest unspoiled virgin bush.** Nyerere National Park boost larger population of Elephants as well as large numbers of Buffalo, Commonly seen are pride of Lion, Hippo, Crocodile and endangered Wild dog. You will also see the Bush buck, Impala, Warthogs, Ostrich, Giraffe, Eland, Baboon, Zebra, Hyena, Kudu, rare sable antelope and Leopard.

In Nyerere National Park there are more than 400 species of bird life: Fish eagle, Kingfisher, Secretary bird, Sunbird, Hammer kop, Red & Yellow bill stork, Open bill stork, Weavers, Water birds, Marabou stork, Vulture's etc. In short, the variety of the wildlife to be explored is endless. Later you will spend your dinner and overnight at **Selous Kinga Lodge** https://selouskingalodge.com/

Day 4: Mikumi National Park

Travelling Time: 6 hrs

Distance: 302 km

After early breakfast you will start your journey from **Nyerere National Park** to **Mikumi National park** in Morogoro. During the afternoon you will **check-in the park for a half day game drive until evening**. Later you will spend your dinner and overnight at **Mikumi Bandas** – **Government cottage.**

Day 5: Mikumi National Park – Full Wildlife Game Drive

After early breakfast **6:00 AM** you will start a **full day game viewing drive** in the Mikumi National Park. This park is Tanzania's fourth-largest national park. It's also the most accessible from Dar Es Salaam and other regions, with almost guaranteed wildlife sightings like **Lions**, **Elephants**, **Buffalos**, **Leopard**, **zebras etc** it makes an ideal safari destination for those without much time.

You will see the vast herds of game such as wildebeest, impala, zebra and giraffe, hunted by their associated predators; while greater kudu, roan and sable antelope are found in the surrounding less fertile hills. **The Hippo Pool site** is in the middle of an area loaded with animals; visitors here may include hyenas, lions, hippos, elephants, Cape buffalo, wildebeast, Impala and more. After the game drive you will start Departing from Mikumi National Park to Dar Es Salaam and drop off at your hotel/home. Later you will spend your dinner and overnight at **Tan-Swiss Lodge** https://tan-swiss.com/en/

Day 6: Ruaha National Park

Travelling Time: 5 hrs 32 Min

Distance: 320 km

After breakfast you will drive from Mikumi National Park to Ruaha National Park and rest ready for the next day game drive in the Ruaha National Park. Later you will spend your dinner and overnight at Ruaha Hilltop Lodge

Day 7: Ruaha National Park – Full Wildlife Game Drive

After breakfast you will drive to **Ruaha National park**. Stop over at the park entrance gate, after which we will later be re-introduced into Ruaha National Park. Continue with game drive and break for lunch. Later continue with evening game viewing along the Great Ruaha river. At about 5 pm, we return to Iringa. Later you will spend your dinner and overnight at **Mount Royal Villa Hotel** https://mountroyalvilla.com/

Day 8: Transfer To Dar Es Salaam City

Travelling Time: 8 hr 33 min

Distance: 488.0 km

After breakfast you will start your journey from **Iringa town to Dar Es Salaam city.** Later you will spend your dinner and overnight at **Tiffany Diamond Hotel** https://www.tiffanydiamondhotels.com/

Day 9: Departure:

Medical Emergency/ Sickness

When a guest gets sick tell your guide immediately for first aid help or call the senior tour guide or the director directly so that a patient can be taken to the hospital as soon as possible.

Emergency For Accident

When a guest gets an accident tell your guide immediately or call the senior tour guide or the director directly for more assistance.

It's important that you know the ambulance emergency number in Tanzania or in the region where you are making a tour with us.

Remember to keep your travel insurance card/details close to you so that it can be easy to use it when needed.

Passport Lost Emergency

If you lose your passport you should immediately tell your tour guide so that he/she can help you to report it to the police or local authorities and get a written report. Then contact your nearest embassy or consulate, so that they can be able to provide you with a temporary passport and further guidance.

Credit Card or Mobile Phone Lost Emergency

If your credit card or mobile phone is lost tell your tour guide immediately for a quick help and communication with our office. Always know where to find the inactivation phone number. Your bank, credit card issuer and mobile phone operator usually has a 24/7 hours emergency number for blocking cards.

Money Lost Emergency

If you loose your money, tell your tour guide immediately for necessary support. Still you can contact your travel insurance company for guidance, ask friends or family to send you money through quick

transfer services. It's advised not to carry or store large amount of money in cash but it's a good idea to keep a little amount of money with you.

Travel Documents Lost Emergency

If you lose your travel documents such as tickets, car rental vouchers, adventure vouchers etc., tell your tour guide immediately so that Kiliedu Travel & Tours can help you to get a copy of it. For other travel documents that are not replaceable, please contact your travel agent who issued the original document.

Assault Emergency

If you have been the victim of assault you should contact your tour guide immediately so that he can communicate with our office for a quick support to report the incident the police or local authorities. Seek medical attention if needed and call your travel insurance company who can advise you further.

Detention and jail Emergency

In case you are locked up in Tanzania Kiliedu Travel & Tours will make a quick effort to communicate with your embassy or consulate in Tanzania or the nearest one for any necessary help. Advised to obey the country laws while staying in any foreign country including Tanzania.

Natural Disasters Emergency

While in Tanzania, If a natural disaster occur like flooding, tropical storms, earthquakes, tsunamis etc follow the guidelines of local authorities and try not to panic but keep focused in the event of evacuation and emergencies etc.

All guests in Tanzania are covered by AMREF emergency response. In any case where guests need to be evacuated out of Tanzania. AMREF will cover all emergency responses.

Death Emergency

In the unlikely event of death while staying in Tanzania such as a family member or a travel companion you must urgently report to your tour guide, Senior tour guide and the Director so that they can take the appropriate measures. This includes reporting to the local authorities, your country's embassy or consulate and the guest travel insurance company.
